



Lakeside Chalet is a four-bedroom house situated on the edge of Lake Sambell. Lake Sambell is a man made lake and recreational area which was the original site used for gold sluicing, mining and dredging by the Rocky Mountain Mining Company. Lakeside Chalet offers unique and superb views capturing a shimmering lake with ducks and abundant bird life just metres from the house. Most of the main rooms have large windows, which take advantage of wonderful sights such as people boating, fishing and swimming. Guests can dine al fresco on the patio or picnic at Lake Sambell's picnic area where you will find BBQ facilities and a playground. A bocce/cricket pitch and



outdoor furniture are just outside the house. Visitors are welcome to fish and swim opposite the house or enjoy the scenic walking tracks nearby. The house is situated at the start of the Rail Trail bike track and is close to the tennis court, library and shops. It is walking distance to the Chinese Gardens, main street, Information Centre, Historical Precinct and original Beechworth Gaol.

Guests can book 1 up to 4 rooms (full house). The house has two levels, which can be booked separately or together. Each level has a bathroom, lounge room, kitchen and two bedrooms, each with a queen size bed and the other with twin



singles. The house can comfortably accommodate eight people. Fittings and fixtures are of a very high quality. The house is clean and the gardens very well maintained. Heating and cooling are provided by means of reverse cycle air conditioners. Electric blankets and all linen are supplied as well as a cot and high chair. The house also has many appliances such as a dishwasher, microwave, stove, fry pan, toaster, sandwich maker, fridge's, TV's, VCR's, D.V.D's (on both levels), and crockery and cutlery.

Once at Lakeside, you will not want to leave.
